

Notice to Contributors

Egypt. J. Derm & Androl is published quarterly and will publish original articles on all aspects of Dermatology, Venereology & Andrology.

Manuscripts:

1. Should be sent to: Prof. Dr. Mohsen Soliman, 11 El-Falaky Square, Bab El-louk, Cairo, Egypt.
2. They should be Computer written and filed on a computer disc.
3. The name (s) of the author (s) should be written (First name, followed by middle name, then family name) on a separate page together with the title.
4. The second page should bear the title (without author's name) and abstract of the content. The succeeding pages will bear the rest of the article.
5. Three (3) copies of the article and photographs are needed.
6. Tables and figure captions should be placed at the end of the article.

Preparation Manuscripts:

- Structured abstract that states the problem or purpose, the major observations, the methods, results and principal conclusions.
- Introduction to briefly answer “why did you start” or “what initiated the research”. State study objective and omit extensive review of literature.

- **Subjects and methods:** answer the question “what did you do”

- **Results:** answer the question “what answer did you get”.

- **Discussion:** point out significant data, do not repeat the introduction. It is to be 1/3 of total manuscript, and not more than 1/2 of total article. Short paragraphs should answer “what did you find out” and “what does it mean”. The second question is answered by discussing your findings in the light of other reports, including opposing views, and is important in limiting bias. Use the last paragraph to suggest extensions of your study.

- **Conclusion:** be sure to indicate a clearly labeled conclusion.

- **References:** Make sure that all references have been verified, that all have been mentioned in the text, and that numbering of the references matches the order of their mention in the text (i.e. reference numbers should appear in consecutive numerical order in the text by Arabic numerals in parentheses). The reference list should be typed double-spaced on a separate page. Reference format (Vancouver style) should conform to that set forth in “Uniform Requirements for Manuscripts Submitted to Biomedical Journals”. It is based largely on an ANSI standard style adapted by the NLM for its databases. Notes have been added where Vancouver style differs from the style now used by the NLM. Journal names

must be abbreviated according to the Cumulated Index Medicus. The list can also be obtained through the library's web site (<http://www.nlm.nih.gov>).

Avoid using abstracts as references

Format for journal articles:

List first three authors and then add et al.):
 - Friedman-Kien AE, Lafleur FL, Gendler E, et al. Herpes zoster: a possible early clinical sign for development of acquired immunodeficiency syndrome in high-risk individuals. *J Am Acad Dermatol* 1986;14:1023-8.
- 2- Organization as author The cardiac society of Australia and New Zealand. Clinical exercise stress testing. Safety and performance guidelines. *Med J Aust* 1996; 164:282-4
- 3- No author given Cancer in South Africa (editorial). *S Afr Med J* 1994;84:15.
- 4- Article not in English (Note: NLM translates the title to English, encloses the translation in square brackets, and adds an abbreviated language designator.)

5- VOLUME WITH SUPPLEMENT.

- 6- Issue with supplement.
- 7- Volume with part.
- 8- Issue with part.
- 9- Issue with no volume

BOOKS and other Monographs:

- 1- Personal authors.
 - 2- Editor(s), compiler(s) as authors
 - 3- Organization as author and publisher
 - 4- Chapter in a book.
 - 5- Conference proceedings
 - 6- Conference paper
 - 7- Scientific or technical report.
 - 8- Patent.
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- 1- Double space all parts of manuscripts.
 - 2- Begin each section or component on a new page.
 - 3- Review the sequence: title page, abstract and key words, text, acknowledgments, references, tables (each on separate page), legends
 - 4- Illustrations, unmounted prints, should be no larger than 20x25cm.
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- 6- Submit required number of paper copies.
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 - i- Title of article
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 - iv- Short title
- 4- Abstract
- 5- Article proper
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Cost for publication

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Maximum 10 pages, extra pages will be charged more.

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A. Black & white: LE 60 or \$ 25 for 4 photographs or less. NB submit 3 prints (6 x 9).

B. Colour : minimum LE 300 or \$ 200 for 4 photographs or less (NB submit positive slides).

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
